

I. Log In

Visit https://paymybill.uillinois.edu/Access and select your campus to login to your Student Account.




II. Review Your Bill and Make a Payment

From 'View and Pay Accounts' screen, select 'Make a Payment' from the navigation menu. Enter the amount you wish to pay to University of Illinois, select 'CIBC' and click the 'Continue' button.

III. Review Details & Continue to CIBC's Portal


Confirm your information is correct, then click the 'Continue' button to process your payment.



IV. Enter Your Country & Select Payment Type

You are now in CIBC's payment portal. The amount you will be paying will be automatically populated. Select the country you are paying from, and click 'Next'. Select your payment type and click 'Next'.


- CIBC will automatically display the amount you need to pay in your local currency and the available payment options based on your country.
- CIBC will convert your currency at the preferred Foreign Exchange rates provided exclusively to University of Illinois students, and pay your institution. Note: your student account will automatically be credited.
- While CIBC supports 120+ currencies, if your home currency is not available, you can select a different currency by clicking the currency dropdown menu.



V. Enter your Student and Payer Details


Enter the student and payer details.

- Note: depending on the country/payment method selected, additional information might be required to facilitate a faster payment process.
- On the 'Payer Details' page, select the relationship the payer has with the student. If it is the student making the payment, check the 'Use student info' box and the information will pre-populate to mirror the student information.



VI. Confirm Payment Details

Review all transaction details. If you have an account, log in so you can see previous transactions made through CIBC's portal. If you do not have an account, you can create one or continue as a guest. Agree to the Terms and Conditions, then click 'Submit' and 'I Agree'.




VII. Additional Steps based on Payment Type


Depending on the payment method selected, you will have a few additional, easy-to-follow steps. Note: each country will have different payment options.

A. Bank Wire

The bank wire payment type is available in all countries. Note, once you submit the transaction on the CIBC portal, you did not send the funds. One you submit the transaction on the portal, a unique instruction sheet will be generated. The instruction sheet will also be sent to the student and payer.

- Download the instruction sheet by clicking 'Download Instruction Sheet'.
- Depending on your bank, send the wire online or visit your local bank and complete the wire in-person using the instruction sheet.
 - The bank will simply follow the instructions on the sheet and wire the funds to University of Illinois.
- CIBC holds the FX rate for you for 72 hours. Make sure you wire the funds within that timeframe.
- Please note: Each new payment will require a corresponding new transaction to be submitted on portal. Do not reuse instruction sheets for other future payments.






B. Credit or Debit Card - Visa/Mastercard

Credit or Debit card are available in all countries. Note: a 2.5% convenience fee will be charged for this payment type by the processor. This fee is not charged by the University of Illinois System or CIBC.


- On the payer details page, you will need to input your card details which will be validated in real-time.
- Once you click submit, you will be redirected to a secure application to authenticate the card holder.
 - Select the method you would like to receive your one-time authentication code. The phone number will be the one linked to your account. Click 'Continue'.
 - Input the code received, and click 'Confirm'.



C. China UnionPay (CUP) - Debit or Credit Card

China UnionPay is only available for payments made from China. Note: a convenience fee will be charged for this payment type by the processor. This fee is not charged by the University of Illinois System or CIBC.


- Once you submit the transaction on the CIBC portal, you will be redirected to China UnionPay's secure website.
- Input card credentials, and submit the transaction.



D. Alipay

Alipay is only available for payments made from China. Note: a convenience fee will be charged for this payment type by the processor. This fee is not charged by the University of Illinois System or CIBC.


- Once you submit the transaction on the CIBC portal, you will be redirected to Alipay's account login/QR Code page to complete the transaction.
- Complete the payment on the Alipay website or scan the QR code to be redirected to the payment app to finalize the payment.



E. WeChat

WeChat is only available for payments made from China. Note: a convenience fee will be charged for this payment type by the processor. This fee is not charged by the University of Illinois System or CIBC.


- Once you submit the transaction on the CIBC portal, you will be redirected to WeChat Pay QR Code page to complete the transaction.
- Scan the QR code to be redirected to the WeChat app to finalize the payment.



F. Direct Debit - Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT)

Direct Debit EFT is only available for payments made from Canada.


- On the payer details page, you will need to input your account details.
- You will need to agree to the Pre-Authorized Debit Agreement. Note: CIBC will debit your account within 3 days.



VIII. Track Your Payment Status Online

You will receive notification updates throughout the entire process until your payment is processed. Keep in mind that University of Illinois may take 2-3 business days to post your payment to your student account once the transaction has been processed.

- You can track your payment 24/7 using the unique reference ID generated for each transaction. Go to the CIBC portal, and click 'Track you payment'. Enter the reference ID and click 'View your payment'.
 - You can receive a receipt via email by clicking 'Receive receipt'.
